- Be able and willing to leverage personal digital networks to expand awareness of and donor base for ALDEA.
- Be willing to travel to Guatemala once during council term to participate in a 3-4 day ALDEA board of directors meeting and village visits (\$500 stipend awarded to each attendee). *Dependent upon COVID-related restrictions.*
- Log and track your contributed hours to ALDEA internship activities.
- Become familiar with ALDEA's mission, strategic plan, and program priorities.
- Maintain confidentiality of ALDEA board information where applicable.
